Upcoming Pulls

The next pull is coming fast. Hopefully this newsletter gets to you before the pull. I know I am a little slow getting a newsletter out but between work, club activities and family I haven't had time to get a lot of things done.

On September 23, we will pull at Skiatook. The pull will start at the 11:00 am. There is a parade at 9:00 a.m. also. If you want to be in the parade you need to be at the High School at 8:30 am.
