GREETINGS

The 2009 pulling season is about here. I hope you have been working on your tractors and getting them ready for this year. Keep your calendars open for May and June because we are planning on filling the weekends for you.

Back in January we had a membership meeting and discussed some possible rule changes. The Board of directors has met and incorporated some of those suggestions. We are going to try separating the Classic 3300 pound class into two classes. One for tractors 22 HP or less and another for those over 22 HP. We will try it for this season and see how that works. The other notable change is how year end points are figured. In the past paint and originality points accounted for about 1/2 of the year end total. Under the new points calculations the paint and originality points will be worth 1/4 of the year end total. We are also trying to push our youth driver program. If you know a youngster 12 years old, and up, that would be interested in pulling please bring them along. Mike Osborn and Greg Zumber are in charge of the youth driver program. Rules can be found on the EDGE & TA website, (www.edgeta.org). I will personally pay this year's membership fee for new youth drivers who sign up for this season (This year only). Please pass the word and find us some young people.
