On September 28th -30th, we hosted the Autumn Iron Show in Broken Arrow. We had pulls on Friday night and Saturday evening. There were 130 total hooks for the two day event. Most of the pullers were our own but we did have some from OATA, a couple of new members, one from Arkansas and one from Missouri.

The track was a little soft due to recent rains and the smaller tractors had some trouble moving the sled. On Saturday when the track started packing down the pull went much better. On Friday it was so soft we almost got the pull-back tractor stuck once.

On Saturday morning I counted 96 tractors. There were another 10-12 tractors came in after that. I believe having over 100 tractors was fantastic for our first attempt at a show. We also had several pieces of machinery there. We had two people baling hay with stationary balers, several people plowed and disked, and the thresher was on display. Courtney even had a John Deere combine on display. A few a gas engine people came and set up displays.
