We got off to a little bit of a slow start but we are about to get real busy. There are 6 pulls scheduled for May and June. Four of those are on consecutive weekends. I have been emphasizing for some time that if you want a pull in your area, if you will plan it and set it up, we will be there. Brian Felkins stepped up first and asked to put a pull on at Talala. Then Mike Avant called and wanted to have one in Okmulgee. This last weekend Ronald Dowden decided he wanted one at Oologah for their town festival. This pull was not on the schedule previously. Each of these guys has tracked down sponsorship, trophies, pull back and blade tractors and the location to have a pull. This is great.

Our next pull is May 13th, at Kent's. You will turn in off of Union, (about 84th St.) at the oil tanks. This will be our **cookout and double pull.** We will start about 11:00 a.m. and pull to about 12:30, stop and eat, and then go back to pulling. This pull will count as two sets of points, but we will give only one set of trophies, for the average. CASTA will provide hamburgers, hotdogs, and buns. Everyone please bring something to go with them such as chips, beans, drinks (no alcohol), or whatever. I'm trying to recruit a few people to help cook the hamburgers and do the serving. If you have a spouse or kids who would like to help please call or e-mail me.

The OATA show is June 16th and 17th. The pull is on Saturday the 17th, at 4:00 p.m. Everyone should try to attend both days. There will be other events both days sponsored by OATA that you will be welcome to participate in.
